2023 Israel Trip

"Our 2023 Israel trip was an experience of a lifetime. We were able to see many cities mentioned in the Bible and areas where Jesus walked and preached during His ministry. We went to Caesarea Philippi, Bethlehem, Golan Heights, the Wailing Wall, the Temple Mount, Masada, Caesarea Maritime, Jerusalem, the Jerusalem Museum where the Dead Sea Scrolls are kept, and so many other places. We visited Capernaum where Jesus taught in the synagogue, and where Peter lived. We worshiped on a boat on the Sea of Galilee. At the Dead Sea we experienced floating on our backs in super buoyant conditions. We stayed at five-star resorts with one buffet after another, but that didn't stop us from walking a total of 47+ miles over the 11day trip. Five of us were baptized in the Jordan River, what a special treat that was for everyone.



It is hard to put into words what visiting Israel meant to us, visiting where our Savior taught, healed, lived, died and rose again. When experiencing a trip like this, reading the Bible takes a whole new light because of the places we visited. The last area we went to was Petra, and it did not disappoint. We were able to walk through the Siq and visit the Treasury deep in the canyons, along with the opportunity to ride a camel and go horseback riding."

Pastor Leticia Mendoza leads the New Mercy Deaf Church and wants to thank God and Faith Chapel for providing a place for the deaf community to grow in the knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ here in Spring Valley. Pastor Leticia writes: "We meet every Wednesday at 6:30pm with Sunday Worship at 10:30am in Room LL1. Deaf church members communicate through American Sign Language (ASL). New Mercy Deaf is having Revival!! God is touching and changing lives!! In May 2019, our first year to join under Faith Chapel, we were able to host the 56th Annual California Deaf State Rally. We had over 400 deaf from southern to northern California join the conference. In March 2022, we had three deaf students receive their Certified Level -Certificate from Global University Bible College. In July 2022 our team traveled to Mexico to assist in the AG First National Congress for the deaf in Monterrey, Nuevo Leon, Mexico. In April 2023 we will be starting Bible college in American Sign Language. Soon we will be training deaf leaders to help the deaf community in "Living Free" helping them to return to a normal state of health, mind, and strength in the Lord by overcoming:

- Destructive behavior
- Harmful emotions

- Negative attitudes
- Unhealthy relationships
- Substance abuse"
